The Secret Sister program is an exchange that is open to all active members of the Seabreeze Quilt Guild. Participants are paired to exchange gifts on a **monthly** basis, (birthday gifts are not required, but a card is nice). The cost of the gift should be between \$5 and \$10. Preferably gifts would be quilt related. A quilt related gift that you make yourself would be greatly appreciated.

Read your Secret Sister profile and ask the coordinator or other guild members (spies) to help you gather any other info you might find helpful about your secret sister. Remember this is about her and what she likes. If she loves pink, don't buy her the most fabulous shade of green you've ever seen. This is about her, not you.

If you will not be able to attend a guild meeting, you need to either send the gift in with another guild member or send it in the mail. If mailing, please feel free to use the Guild's PO Box address for the return address. Many online quilt shops will mail to your secret pal if requested. Also, setting up a phony e-mail name to correspond with her is loads of fun. Example, yoursecretsister@yahoo.com. Please call the SS coordinator to let her know if the gift will not be at the meeting and what arrangements have been made for the gift. It is extremely important to keep the coordinator advised as this will enable her to talk to your SS before the meeting.
