

## Easy Baby Sashed Quilt

### Need:

$\frac{1}{2}$  yard of main fabric,  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of sashing fabric,  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard of cornerstone fabric

### Cut:

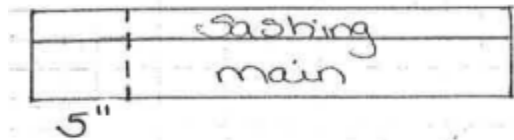
From main fabric cut 3 - 5" strips

From sashing fabric cut 2 - 5" strips (really need  $1\frac{1}{2}$ ) and 3 - 2" strips

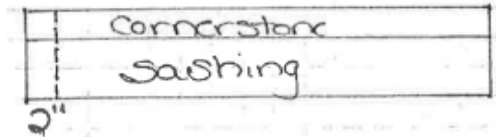
From cornerstone fabric cut 2 - 2" strips (really need  $1\frac{1}{2}$ )

### Directions:

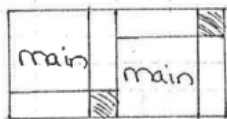
- Sew all 3 main pieces to the 2" sashing pieces
- Cut these 3 strip sets every 5" – you should get at least 7 from each strip set (you need 20)



- Sew all 5" sashing fabrics to 2" cornerstone fabrics & press towards cornerstone fabric
- Cut these strip sets every 2" – you should get at least 16 (you need 20)



- Sew cornerstone strip set to main fabric strip set matching seams and creating 20 blocks
- Press towards cornerstone set, if needed trim to  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- Sew into groups of 2 like picture (main fabric might be upside down)



- Then create top
