## **Color Fabric Layout:**

- Decide which colors you will have in each spot number
- Remember from last directions you already have two top pieces these will be #1 and #2
- Try to have your lighter colors be #3, #4, #8 & #9

## **Cutting Directions from Secondary Background:**

- $3 6\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "
- $12 4\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "
- $15 2\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

## Creating Squares corresponding to #1, #3, #4, #5, #8, & #9


- Place 1 main background 2½" square on 1 of the 4½" x 2½" colored strips **A** and sew diagonally as shown in picture **A** (do twice)
- Place 1 color 2½" square on 1 of the 4½" x 2½" main background strips and sew diagonally as shown in picture **A** (do once)
- Place 1 main background 2½" square on 1 of the 4½" x 2½" colored strips and sew diagonally on opposite corner as shown in picture **B** (do once)
- Place 1 color 2½" square on 1 of the 4½" x 2½" main background strips and sew diagonally on opposite corner as shown in picture **B** (do once) **C**
- Create square like picture C
- Add 6½" x 2½" main background strip to right side as shown in picture D

#### Creating Squares corresponding to #6, #11, & #12

 Do the same as above but instead of main background and color use secondary background (represented by stripes) and color as shown in picture E

#### Creating Squares corresponding to #2, #7, & #10

• Do same as above with secondary background and color but instead of doing step 1 twice do it once with secondary background and color and once with main background and color like picture **F** (don't add edge piece)
